

Dear Parents/Guardians,

According to the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, Section III (h)(6) PARENTS' RIGHT TO KNOW, Tri-County School Corporation must supply, upon request, information regarding teacher qualifications in a Title I school. You have the right to know if a teacher has met the state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas that they are teaching, or if a teacher's instruction is under emergency or temporary status. You also have the right to view their baccalaureate degree major, graduation certification, and field of discipline.

Paraprofessional qualifications and services are also available upon request. If a non-highly qualified teacher is teaching your child for 4 or more consecutive weeks, Tri-County Schools will notify you.
